

Annual Report: Session 2022-23

With a vision and mission to impart a conducive teaching-learning environment to the students, especially females, of the rural areas in the vicinity, and to evolve their personality by furnishing them with a subtle amalgamation of subject knowledge, soft skills, and moral values, Government college Bassa came into being on 24th April, 1999. The college follows the Sanskrit dictum:

meaning thereby, education leads towards humility, humility leads towards worthiness, worthiness leads towards wealth, wealth further leads towards good deeds and righteousness, that finally leads one towards bliss or true happiness.

College At a Glance:

The college is situated by the side of Jiyuni Khud at Khyod, a place between Gohar and Chailchowk, known all over Himachal for its Sair fair. The place is easily accessible through buses and other means of transportation. That is why, more than one thousand students from the surrounding as well as the far flung areas of Seraj, Balh and Nachan constituencies are receiving education here. The college has emerged as a dream come true institution for those girl students who, otherwise, would have been deprived of higher education. Moreover, the pristine natural setting helps create an ideal atmosphere for the teaching-learning process.

In the past few years, the college has made a remarkable infrastructural growth. Apart from this, the college has also registered its identity in the map of Himachal Pradesh University through its outstanding contribution in terms of participation in academic, sports, cultural and other co-curricular activities organised by the university. We have a firm faith that the college will touch the new milestones of success and glory in times to come.

Availability of Various Faculties:

The college offers various courses as prescribed by Himachal Pradesh University under the faculties of Humanities, Science and Commerce. The courses at undergraduate level were offered earlier under the CBCS semester system introduced by Himachal Pradesh University,

Shimla from the academic session 2013-14. The courses under the CBCS semester system underwent a change in the academic session 2016-17. From the academic session 2016-17 onwards, the courses at undergraduate level were offered under the new CBCS semester system introduced by UGC and adopted by HPU, Shimla. As per the guidelines of Himachal Pradesh Government and Himachal Pradesh University, a major change in new CBCS semester system has been brought about by converting it, once again, into an annual system *w.e.f.* the academic session 2018-19. Under this system, the students can opt for core courses, elective courses (Discipline specific courses, Generic elective courses and dissertation/projects) and Ability Enhancement Compulsory courses in Humanity, Science and Commerce.

Recently, the college has been affiliated with the newly formed Sardar Patel University, Mandi. At present, the second and final year courses are being administered by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla however, the first year is being regulated by Sardar Patel University, Mandi.

National Conference:

Govt. College Bassa (Gohar), organised a National Conference in a hybrid mode on “Science, Spirituality and Education” on 23rd December, 2023. The conference was organised in collaboration with the Pratibha Spandan Society, Shimla. It was the maiden conference on hybrid mode in Mandi District. All the teaching as well as non-teaching staff actively participated to make the event successful. Many of the members of the teaching faculty presented their papers in the conference. A total of 81 papers were presented through both online as well as offline mode.

Dr. Raj Kumar Singh, Professor, Dept. of Commerce, presided over the inaugural ceremony. Dr. I. D. Sharma, Retd. Principal, was the Guest of Honour. The Keynote speech was delivered by Prof. J.N. Baliya, Head, Dept. of Education Studies and Dept, of Mass Communication and Media, Central University Jammu (J&K). Dr. R.K. Abhilashi, Chancellor Abhilashi University and Chairman of Abhilashi Education Society presided over the felicitation ceremony. Dr. L.K. Abhilashi, Pro-Chancellor Abhilashi University/ M.D. Abhilashi Group of Institutions was kind enough to be the Guest of Honour.

Infrastructural Facilities:

Girls' Hostel: Govt. College Bassa has a girls' hostel, with a capacity of 60 students. Though the hostel was run successfully earlier, yet as an after effect of Covid-19 Pandemic, no girl students are residing there in the hostel at present. The college administration is hopeful that the girl students will enrol themselves as boarders in the coming time.

Library: The College has a semi-automated library with 4683 books, 10 magazines of different subjects, 5 daily newspapers and 2 weekly newspapers have been subscribed for the benefit of the students. At present the post of Librarian is lying vacant. All the faculty members are provided access to National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (**N-LIST**) since 5th December, 2019 and it is renewed every year by our college. The faculty members and students can access the books and Research Journals of their interest. This institute also has an access to the **National Digital Library** Portal of Govt. of India. New library management software "Koha" has been installed on the computer of the library.

IT Lab: The College has two IT Labs, one each in the Science and Arts Block. The IT Lab at Arts Block, with Dr. Vikram Singh, Asst. Prof. in Sociology, as its In-charge, has 7 computers and other related gadgets for the use of the students. With the help of RUSA Grant, IT Lab at Science Block has been facilitated with 25 computers. This Lab is being run under the supervision of Dr. Gagan Rajput, Asst. Prof. in Physics.

Smart Classroom: College has a Smart Classroom in Arts Block with a capacity of 60 students. The teachers are making optimal use of this facility as an aid to their classroom teaching. The classroom is under the supervision of Dr. Shivendra Sangar, Assistant professor in Economics.

Photostat Machine: A Photostat machine has also been installed in the college office for the benefit of the students.

Sanitary Napkin Vending Machines: Sanitary Napkin Vending Machines along with the incinerators have been installed in the Arts and Science Blocks of the college.

House Examinations:

House examination of B. A./B. Sc./B. Com. 1st, 2nd and 3rd year were conducted from 8th February, 2023 to 23rd February, 2023 during the session 2022-23. Almost 100% students appeared in these exams and the answer sheets were evaluated by the concerned teachers.

Old Students Association:

The Old Students Association of GC Bassa (Gohar) was constituted on 19th November, 2016. Since then, the association has contributed significantly in the development and up-gradation of the college. Challenges and Obstacles:

However this College is performing very well in all the areas, but the institution is still facing the following problems:

- The sanctioned posts of Sanskrit, Physical Education, Public Administration, Zoology, Tabla Player are lying vacant. Though PTA of College has provided a teacher in Sanskrit, a Sweeper and a Tabla-player out of local PTA fund during the session 2021-22 in the interest of the students and the institute.
- Keeping in view the increased syllabi under RUSA, one additional post in each subject of English, Hindi, History, Political Science, Mathematics and Sociology is needed in the college.
- For smooth running of office work, an administrative block is a dire need of the College.

- The College does not have a playground of its own for the sports activities. At present, College uses Panchayat ground.
- College is in urgent need of a boundary wall. However, it will be possible only after the transfer of the land to the College. The College has some land issues pending with the forest department that needs to be resolved at the The College does not have an auditorium and stadium. At present, the multi-purpose hall of Arts Block is being used to organise various cultural and co-curricular activities.
